*(1) Throughout both the Magnificat and Nunc Dimitis the shifting time signatures are less metric subdivisions and more a parsing of the chant text phrases. The underlying note pulse is constant. (2) Phrasing slurs are mostly omitted in both the choral and organ parts since, unless otherwise indicated, text phrases dictate the arc of the musical phrase.
